Center Volunteer: Volunteers in this role will work with students on college and career exploration in SCOPE and should plan to commit at least 2-3 volunteer shifts per month during the school year calendar. A typical center volunteer shift is 3 hours during the school day.

-  SAT/ACT test prep support
-  Technical workforce opportunities
