Using Digital Resources with Limited Mobility

- o Use voice recognition and talk to your device
- o Use a keyboard instead of a mouse
 - Use keyboard shortcuts or try turning on Sticky Keys in settings if you have trouble pressing multiple keys at the same time. Sticky Keys will leave on modifiers like "Ctrl" and "Shift" so you can press the shortcut keys in sequence instead.
 - You can also change the keyboard settings to one-handed or add an onscreen keyboard to your device
- Make the computer mouse easier to use by making the mouse pointer larger, slowing down your mouse, or making your mouse left-handed. If you have trouble double-clicking the mouse, you can slow down the mouse's double click speed.
