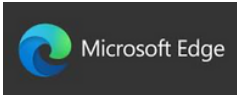

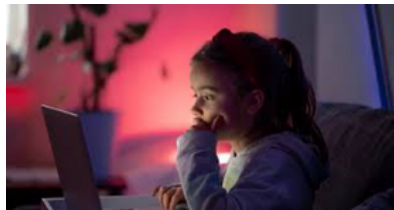


1. Password generator for Microsoft Edge
